



Fun ideas to make yourself



Three-dimensional puff-up fabric paint feels as soft as velvet on cushions. Just snuggle up...

Degree of difficulty ① ② ③

To tear off, take away and collect





From Marabu you will need...

- Textil 3D in 3D-orange (613), 3D-ruby red (638), 3D-pink (633)
- Textil-Collection cushion covers (105)
- Stencil "flowers + ornaments" (014), 15 x 30 cm
- Robust stencil brush No. 10
- fix it adhesive spray

... you will also need:

- masking tape

Here's how it's done

1. Cover work surface and lay out the cushion cover (approx. 40 x 40 cm) smoothly. Insert a sheet of paper inside the cushion so that the paint does not seep through to the back. Then mask off 3 stripes roughly in the middle of the cushion with masking tape.
2. Thinly spray fix it onto the reverse of the stencil, allow to become tacky. Then lay the stencil onto the lower half of the cushion and press firmly.
3. First evenly and thinly dab the stripes in pink, orange and ruby red using a stencil brush pushing the paint firmly into the fabric by holding the stencil brush vertically. Then colour in the stencil using the same 3 colours. To achieve a smooth velvet effect it is important that the paint is applied thinly as it puffs up thick during fixing. Try on a test piece first if necessary. Allow everything to dry for at least 6 hours.
4. **Fixing/puff up:** Iron each painted area on reverse side on cotton setting for 2-3 min. on a soft underlay (e.g. a thick terry cloth) without pressure, until paint puffs up and looks matt. Or fix in a pre-heated oven (150°C) for 8 min. Then wash-resistant up to 40°C (gentle wash). Always wash and iron inside out.

Tip:

Using Marabu-Textil 3D, textiles of any kind (cotton and blended textiles up to a maximum of 20% synthetic fibres, pre-washed, free of finishing and softening agents) can be painted.
