You can never have enough toy boxes. Using Textil Painters Glitter, even baseball caps can be painted with cars!

Degree of difficulty **1** 2 3

To tear off, take away and collect





From Marabu you will need...

- Textil Painter Glitter in glitter-yellow (519), glitter-orange (523), glitter-red (532), glitter-pink (533), glitter-violet (551), glitter-blue (555), glitter-green (567), glitter-black (573), glitter-silver (582)

... you will also need:

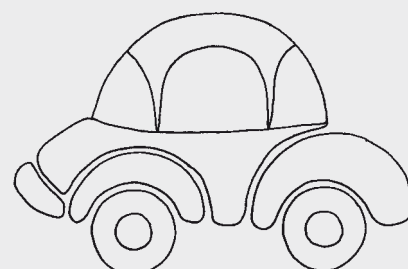
- 1 box, covered with fabric (or other textiles, see tips)
- carbon paper for fabric

Here's how it's done

1. Photocopy the motif to the desired size (perhaps enlarge). Insert carbon paper between box and pattern (rub-off side must face downwards) and trace all lines of the motif without slipping. Trace several cars and traffic signs like this.
2. Now paint in the cars and the traffic signs with colours.
3. Finally paint the outlines of all the cars and traffic-signs in glitter-black. Allow to dry.
4. **Fixing** (only required for textiles which must be washed): Iron each painted area for 5 min. on cotton setting, through a thin cotton cloth. Fixing is also possible in the oven: 8 min. at 150°C.

Tips:

- Because of their excellent coverage, water based Textil Painters, are suitable for quickly painting fabrics of any kind (cotton and blended textiles up to a maximum of 20 % synthetic fibres, pre-washed, free of finishing and softening agents). Wash-resistant up to 40°C (gentle wash) after fixing. Always wash and iron inside out.
- Shake well before first use with the cap closed. Then press down onto the tip repeatedly for a short time until the ink is visible.
